

Born in Ottawa 1943, I lived in Brampton 1946-1049. My family and I moved to Perry Sound whre I grew up on the shores of Gergian Bay and attended elementary and secondary school. I began curling in 1956 and have curled for 61 years. After graduating from Hamilton Teacher's College in 1964, I began teaching at Rousseau Public School in Ancaster. In September 1966, I entered McMaster University in the faculty of Geography and graduated in 1971. I began teaching at Nelson High School in Burlington where I taught grade nine Canadian Geography. In later years I, also, taught grade ten History. I retired in June 2000 with thirty-five years invested in he Teacher's Pension Plan. After retirement I worked part-time for the Wine Rack and became a certified Wine Merchant.

Married in 1971, my wife Dianne and I had three children: Colin, Scott, and Heather. The latter two presently teaching elementary school.
